

CHILD TRAVEL CONSENT FORM

Dear Traveler,

It is highly recommended by the U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) to fill out the attached form for any minors (18 years old and below) traveling with an adult who is not their parent or legal guardian, or if one parent is traveling with their child without the accompaniment of the other parent.

While this form is not required by the U.S., if the CBP asks for this sort of documentation at the border and you do not have it, you could be detained until the circumstances of the child traveling without both parents can be fully evaluated. This can really interrupt travel plans, and any delays, cancellations, and various financial repercussions will be at your own expense.

As the lead traveler in charge of the minor, it is your responsibility to contact their parents/legal guardians to have them fill out and sign the attached form. Please obtain the signatures of BOTH parents/legal guardians in order to verify their consent. The letter is not required to be notarized for the U.S., but it is highly recommended. After the form is filled out, you will need to keep it on your person throughout your travels with the minor.

Please note that while the U.S. does not always require this documentation, many other countries have strict requirements (this is especially true for Canada). Adults traveling with children who do not have the notarized consent letters, and/or the child's birth certificate could be refused entry to said country at their own expense. For further information and specific legal requirements, please contact the U.S. Embassy in your countries of travel.
